- Please provide up to five samples of the nominee's work from 2021, along with a letter of nomination from the editor or publisher, noting the contribution and achievements of the nominee as well as a statement to the length of the nominee's professional career.
- **For a nominee to be considered, you must attach biographical information.**
- Include a photo of the nominee if available.

# **EMERGING JOURNALIST AWARD**

Purpose of Award: The APA Emerging Journalist Award is designed to recognize excellence in the field of journalism and maintained high standards of quality and ethics. The award aims to reinforce the importance of a journalist's role by recognizing and nurturing talent to promote quality journalism.

Eligibility: Nominees must be an employee or regular contributor to an APA-member newspaper. This award is open to nominees younger than 30 with less than five years of experience writing professionally for a newspaper.

Selection Procedure: The selection committee is made up of the four APA officers and two additional board members.

Award Presentation: The award will be presented at the APA Media Summit along with the presentation of the Lifetime Achievement Award. A plaque will be presented and time allotted for a response from the recipient.

Entries: Nominations should include up to five samples of the nominee's work from the previous calendar year and must be accompanied by a letter of nomination from the editor or publisher, noting the contributions and achievements of the nominee as well as a statement to the length of the nominee's professional career. Nominations will be judged on the quality and variety of work samples and the impact of the nominee's work in the community.
